

## Pastor Kathleen's Corner

"Ch-ch-ch-changes. Turn and face the strange.
Ch-ch-changes ... Time may change me.
But I can't change time." Song "Changes" by David Bowie

You will not hear me saying "I love change" very often.
But, as a United Methodist pastor, change is something that happens, whether I am ready for it or not. As you know, I will be retiring as your pastor this June. I am staying in the area (I live in Surprise.)
I will miss being your pastor and I will miss you, but am looking forward to the adventures ahead of me in retirement!
As was announced earlier this year, Bishop Carlo Rapanut is appointing Pastor Jody Topping as the new pastor here. She will be starting on July 1 and her first Sunday will be July 7. I know Pastor Jody and appreciate her ministry — she will be a blessing to this church.



Here are some ideas to welcome her (& her husband, David) to First UMC of Sun City — **Open your hearts and decide that you are going to love your new pastor.** Your love and caring has been a precious gift to me — share that love and caring!

**Being Invited To Things** This one may sound simple but when you are the new person in town, it can be a bit overwhelming. Being invited over for dinner or to meet someone for lunch or coffee is important in getting to know people and in developing relationships.

#### Pray For Your New Pastor and Tell Her That You Are Praying for her

There is something that is so reassuring to know that other people are specifically praying for you. This is encouraging for at least two reasons. First, it is encouraging to know that there is spiritual maturity in this new flock of people in that they are praying for you. And second, it is nice to know that these new people care and love you enough to pray to God for you. Both of these reasons will be important to your new pastor.

Love Her And Honor Her Family Love them all and show them that you accept them. Keep them in your prayers as well. Welcome them to this church and help them to feel at home.

#### Don't Compare Your New Pastor To The Last Pastor

Even if you are saying things in a positive way, it is not helpful to be comparing one pastor to another. Each pastor brings their own set of spiritual gifts and abilities that God has given them to this job of shepherding the local church. Embrace that and look forward to discovering what the new pastor brings, and, please, don't compare.

**Tell Your New Pastor Your Name Often** You all do such a great job with wearing your nametags! I have so appreciated that! Please keep it up --it will help Pastor Jody not only remember you but to make her feel at ease as she learns many names and faces.

Each one of us desires to feel loved and wanted and your new pastor is no different. Go out of your way to let her know that you are truly thankful that she is here to pastor this church. Please keep me, this church, and Pastor Jody in your prayers in this time of "Ch-ch-ch-ch-changes." May we look forward to what God has for us to discover in the months ahead!

#### Pentecost Sunday — May 19

On Pentecost Sunday, we remember the day the disciples received the Holy Spirit in a special way. The story in Acts 2 describes a powerful wind and tongues of fire as the Holy Spirit was poured out on people from all over the world who came to Jerusalem to celebrate a Jewish feast. At the first Pentecost over 3000 people were baptized, creating the first church. This is why Pentecost is known as the birthday of the Christian church!

The word Pentecost comes from a Greek word meaning fiftieth.
The Christian festival of Pentecost falls on the 50th day
after the resurrection of Jesus. Pentecost culminates the celebration
and work of the church begun on Easter Day. It celebrates
the whole congregation living out the gifts we have been given
in the name of Jesus and the power, gifts, and fruit of the Holy Spirit!

RED is the color of Pentecost. You are invited to wear something RED on Sunday, May 19!

UMOM's programs are built around a simple formula: jobs + housing = ending homelessness.

We work hand-in-hand with every person we serve to solve that formula alongside them. From emergency shelter to affordable housing, UMOM offers a full slate of vital services, rooted in a foundation of trust and proactive support.

UMOM's Mission is to end family homelessness by restoring hope and rebuilding lives.

What is UMOM? It stands for United Methodist Outreach Ministries. UMOM New Day Centers mission is to prevent and end homelessness with innovative strategies and housing solutions that meet the unique needs of each family and individual.

About 50% of the family shelter residents are children and youth.

Founded in 1964, UMOM is in Phoenix, Arizona, and is the largest shelter for homeless families in the state. They keep families together — providing a continuum of care from emergency shelter to transitional housing and finally, permanent, affordable housing. Families at UMOM can gain the skills, medical care, quality childcare, and education they need to rebuild their lives and succeed when they leave. Every night UMOM provides safe shelter and supportive services for nearly 700 individuals (over 155 homeless families and 130 single women) through its continuum of services. They also offer over 550 units of affordable housing across the Valley, each community with Program Centers for residents.

Some of their programs and services are: Shelter programs for families, Permanent Housing, Veterans Programs, Watkins Basic Needs Shelter, and Supportive Services (workforce development, child development center, wellness center, teen activity program.)
